Wireless Internet Use Policy

Subject to the terms of this Wireless Internet Use Policy, which has been adopted by the Board of Directors of Donaldson Run Recreation Association (“DRRA”), visitors to DRRA may utilize the wireless Internet connectivity provided by DRRA’s wireless equipment using their own wireless devices.

1. Users assume all risk associated with the use of DRRA’s wireless connection and hold DRRA harmless from any claim or damage arising from such use. DRRA’s wireless connection is not secure and users are cautioned not to transmit sensitive personal information.

2. DRRA’s Staff is focused on protecting the safety of DRRA’s members and guests. DRRA Staff members are not authorized to give technical advice or make changes to a user’s equipment or network settings, and DRRA will not be responsible for harm to equipment arising from a Staff member’s technical advice. DRRA Staff members are not authorized to check or store users’ equipment in the bathhouse or elsewhere.

3. Computer equipment owned by DRRA is reserved for DRRA business. Members and guests are not authorized to use DRRA’s computer equipment for personal use.

4. DRRA maintains a child- and family-friendly environment and all users of DRRA’s wireless connection are expected to utilize it in a legal and responsible manner. Users are prohibited from violating federal, Virginia, or local laws, from transmitting or receiving pornographic or harmful material, or from downloading copyrighted material. Users may not use DRRA’s wireless connection in a manner that offends or disrupts other members and guests.

5. DRRA does not guarantee the availability, capacity, or speed of its wireless Internet connection and reserves the right to discontinue the connection at any time. DRRA’s managers are authorized to direct a user to disconnect from the DRRA wireless connection or to take DRRA’s wireless equipment out of service without notice if, in their sole discretion, use of the wireless connection by a user is causing an unsafe or disruptive condition for any DRRA member, guest, or Staff member or if a user appears to be violating the terms of this policy.

6. Due to the limited availability of electric outlets on DRRA’s premises and the hazards associated with the use of plugged-in electrical devices in the vicinity of the pool and bathhouse, members and guests are prohibited from charging/powering computer equipment or other devices using DRRA’s electric outlets at the bathhouse or elsewhere on the grounds.

7. DRRA will not be responsible for any loss or damage to a member’s or guest’s computer equipment or other devices, including loss or damage to equipment or devices stored in vehicles or lockers. DRRA assumes no responsibility for damage, theft, or loss of any person’s personal information, data, equipment, or software in connection with use of DRRA’s wireless connection. Members and guests should not leave their equipment unattended.

8. Violations of this policy may result in loss of membership privileges pursuant to DRRA’s bylaws.
